Dear Dr. Hartmann and Members of the School Board,

As our district will continue participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the 2026–2027 school year, all students will continue to receive free breakfast and lunch. I am requesting approval of the following increases to our à la carte menu item prices:

- Adult entrée: Increase of \$0.50, bringing the price to \$3.00
- Student entrée: Increase of \$0.50, bringing the price to \$2.50
- Adult meal: No change; will remain \$5.50
- Adult salad: No change; will remain \$5.00

These adjustments are intended to help offset rising food, supply, and operational costs while maintaining the quality and variety of items offered for purchase outside of the reimbursable meal program. The proposed increases will support the financial sustainability of our food service program without affecting students' access to free school meals through CEP.

Thank you for your consideration. I respectfully request your approval of these proposed à la carte price increases for the 2026–2027 school year. Please let me know if you need any additional information.
